

## Residency at UKirk

The residency program at UKirk-UTK serves as a housing and service opportunity for students looking for a deeper experience and connection with the Presbyterian Campus Ministry. We strive to be a positive presence on campus for those looking for a home away from home.

The two-year program offers up to five residents use of the 2nd floor of the house. The apartment has three bedrooms, a kitchen, a living room, two bathrooms, and a separate entrance for privacy and extra security. The basement level, which serves as a common area for UKirk students, has free laundry facilities, a television, and a second kitchen. There is an outdoor patio space, a fire pit, and plenty of yard. Every resident also receives one reserved parking space at the house.

In addition to a monthly rental fee of \$350, residents are expected to help with household chores and yard work (taking out trash, vacuuming, cleaning bathrooms, mowing the lawn, and making sure common areas are kept tidy).

Finally, residents are expected to be active participants in the UKirk program by attending UWorship, Seminary Light, group outings, and special events. Residents are ambassadors for UKirk so a helpful and eager attitude is paramount. Living at the UKirk house means showing hospitality and Christian love to all who walk through the door.

To be considered for residency, students must submit an application and a personal recommendation form an individual who may speak on behalf of your spiritual growth. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 hours each semester and be responsible for a personal list of household chores. Priority is given to juniors and seniors; however, if spots go unfilled, sophomores will be considered.

## **Resident Requirements**

Please initial each requirement to show understanding and agreement. This will be filed with your application and will be required if selected as a resident of UKirk.
The 12 month rental agreement corresponds with the academic year, starting in August and ending in July.
Rent for each resident is \$350 per person, per month, and is due on the 1st of every month.  Residents will be fined \$10 per day for each day rent is late. Late payments are grounds for eviction and will be pursued for 3 late monthly payments.
A security deposit of \$200 is due one month prior to moving in. If no damage beyond "wear and tear" is done to the facility while in residency, the deposit will be returned to the student upon departure. The Board of Directors reserve the right to inspect residents' rooms at the end of the contract to affirm no damage has been done. Residents will be responsible for replacement/repair. Money from the deposit will be used first and resident will be responsible for remaining amount due.
Students who go home for the summer, but plan to return in August are welcome to leave their belongings in their apartment while continuing to pay rent. If a student breaks the rental agreement by moving out prior to July, then he/she forfeits the \$200 deposit, plus one month's rent.
Residents are not insured by UKirk or the Presbytery of East TN. It is recommended the student secure rental insurance through a company of their choice.
Residents are expected to complete weekly duties/chores in exchange for low rent. Duties will be divided at the beginning of each semester. Failure to complete duties will result in meeting with the Executive Board for a Residency Improvement Plan and could lead to eviction.
All residents must regularly attend UWorship, Seminary Light, and be active participants in the UKirk Program. Absences from sanctioned events need prior approval from the Communications Coordinator. Excessive absences will result in meeting with the Executive Board for a Residency Improvement Plan and could lead to eviction.
Respect for fellow advisors is paramount, therefore, all residents must be asked in person and agree before visitors may spend the night. Overnight visitors must stay in the room of the resident they are visiting.
On home game weekends during football season, residents are required to remove their vehicles from the UKirk parking lot as the spaces are used for fundraising.
For the safety of all residents and the facility, all exterior doors should remain locked except during normal business hours when UKirk is open. Interior doors to the apartment should be locked at all times on account of regular foot traffic in the house. Residents may not make duplicate keys. If a key is lost, report to the Communications Coordinator. There may be a fee incurred for replacement keys.

The	e attic is not a storage space for residents. Do not leave any personal items in the attic.
	irk is an alcohol, drug free facility. Smoking is not allowed in the UKirk house at any time. of this policy is grounds for eviction.
